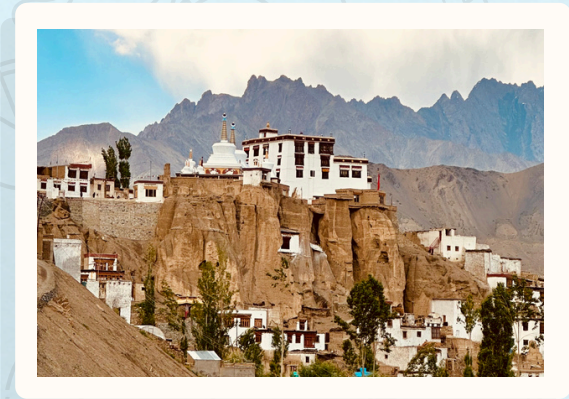

DAY 1

ARRIVAL IN SRINAGAR

- In the evening, enjoy a leisurely walk along the picturesque banks of Dal Lake and soak in the serene beauty of the surroundings. Later, enjoy an included Shikara ride on Dal Lake, offering breathtaking views and a truly memorable experience. Overnight stay in Srinagar. Dinner Included

DAY 2

SRINAGAR - KARGIL VIA DRASS

- After an early breakfast, set off on a scenic and adventurous drive to Kargil. En route, cross the breathtaking Zoji La and pass through Drass, known for its extreme winters.
- Visit the iconic Kargil War Memorial and witness the famous peaks that played a significant role in the 1999 conflict. Upon reaching Kargil, check in to your hotel and relax. Overnight stay in Kargil. Breakfast & Dinner Included



DAY 3

KARGIL TO LEH VIA LAMAYURU

- After breakfast, we begin our journey to Leh, taking one of the most scenic and dramatic highways in Ladakh.
- Drive across the high-altitude passes of Namika La and Fotu La, where endless mountain views unfold at every turn. En route, explore the stunning landscapes of Lamayuru Monastery and its surrounding “Moonland” terrain — famous for its unique, crater-like formations that look straight out of another planet.
- We continue towards Leh, stopping at the picturesque Sangam Point, where the Indus and Zaskar rivers meet in contrasting shades. Pay a visit to the revered Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, a peaceful spiritual stop nestled amidst the mountains. Overnight stay in Leh. Breakfast & Dinner Included



DAY 4

LEH SIGHTSEEING

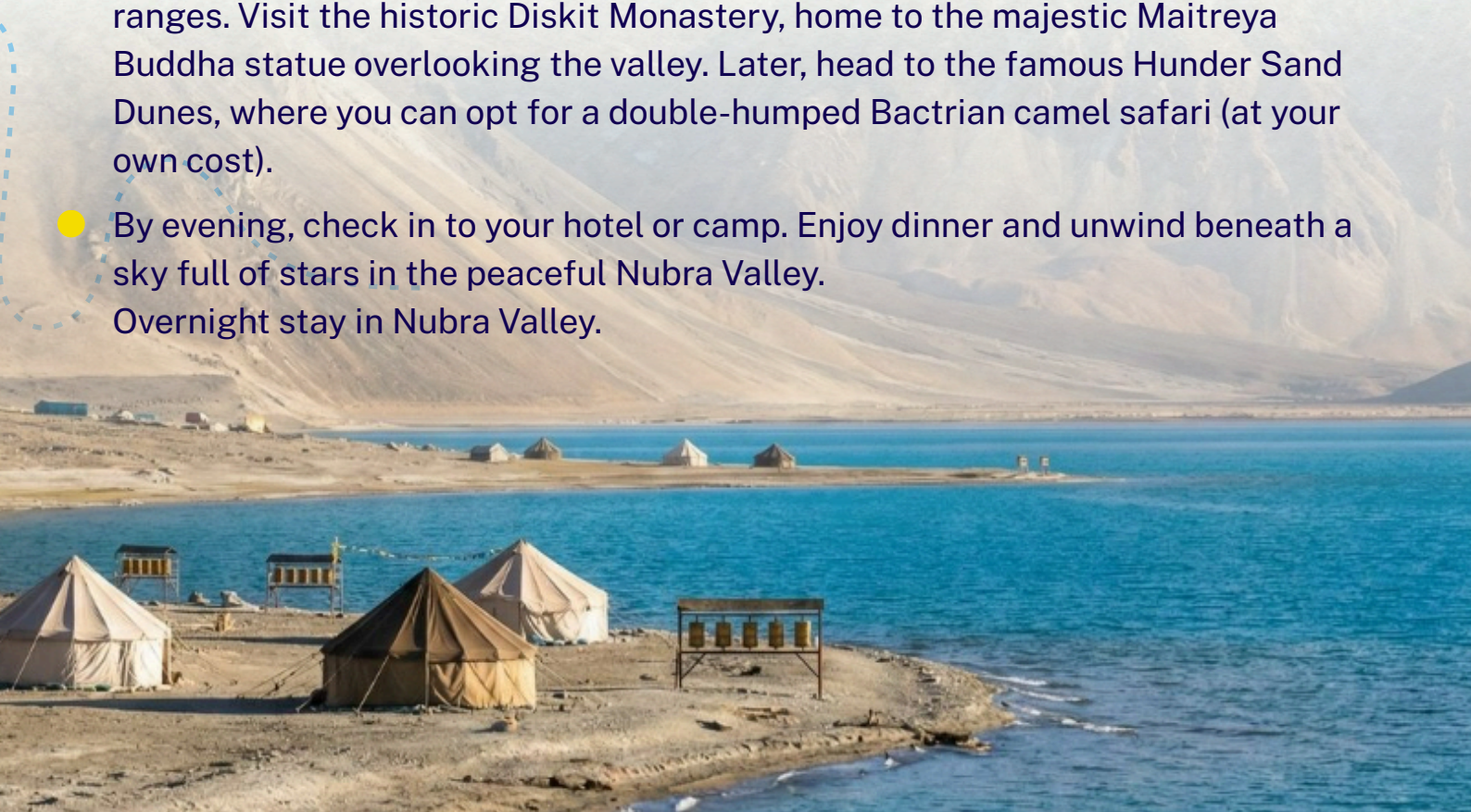
- After breakfast, head out to explore the highlights of Leh. Visit the magnificent Thiksey Monastery, known for its striking architecture and serene atmosphere. Continue to the famous Druk White Lotus School (popularly known as Rancho School), followed by a visit to the inspiring Hall of Fame and the peaceful Shanti Stupa offering panoramic views of Leh town.
- In the evening, enjoy free time to explore the vibrant Leh Market at your own pace. Overnight stay in Leh.

DAY 5

LEH TO NUBRA VALLEY VIA KHardUNG LA

- After breakfast, gear up for one of the most iconic drives of the trip as we cross Khardung La (18,380 ft), among the highest motorable roads in the world.
- As we descend, the landscape dramatically shifts and we enter the surreal cold desert of Nubra Valley, a place where sand dunes meet towering Himalayan ranges. Visit the historic Diskit Monastery, home to the majestic Maitreya Buddha statue overlooking the valley. Later, head to the famous Hunder Sand Dunes, where you can opt for a double-humped Bactrian camel safari (at your own cost).
- By evening, check in to your hotel or camp. Enjoy dinner and unwind beneath a sky full of stars in the peaceful Nubra Valley.
Overnight stay in Nubra Valley.





DAY 6

NUBRA VALLEY - TURTUK - NUBRA

- Today we set out to explore Turtuk, a picturesque village nestled close to the Indo-Pak border. Unlike the stark landscapes of Ladakh, Turtuk welcomes you with greenery, traditional stone homes, & wooden bridges.
- Known for its rich Balti heritage, this village offers a completely different cultural experience & enjoy beautiful views of the Shyok River flowing through the valley. By evening, we drive back to Nubra Valley for dinner and relaxation. Overnight stay in Nubra Valley.

DAY 7

NUBRA VALLEY TO PANGONG LAKE VIA SHYOK ROUTE

- After breakfast, set out on an exhilarating drive to Pangong Lake via the thrilling Shyok River route — a journey through untamed landscapes, dramatic mountain terrains. Arrive at the mesmerizing Pangong Lake and witness its magical waters shift through stunning shades of blue as the sun glides across the sky. Check into charming lakeside cottages, savor a warm dinner, and unwind under a blanket of stars.



DAY 8

PANGONG TO HANLE

- After breakfast, depart from Pangong Lake and drive towards Hanle, a remote and mesmerizing village located close to the Indo-China border. Hanle is renowned for hosting the world-class Indian Astronomical Observatory, one of India's highest astronomical observatories.
- En route, pay your respects at the historic Rezang La War Memorial, dedicated to the brave soldiers of the 1962 Indo-China war. Upon reaching Hanle, visitors may explore the observatory (subject to availability),
At night, if the skies are clear, witness the breathtaking view of the Milky Way shining brilliantly above. Overnight stay in Hanle (Homestay with shared washrooms) Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

DAY 9

HANLE TO LEH

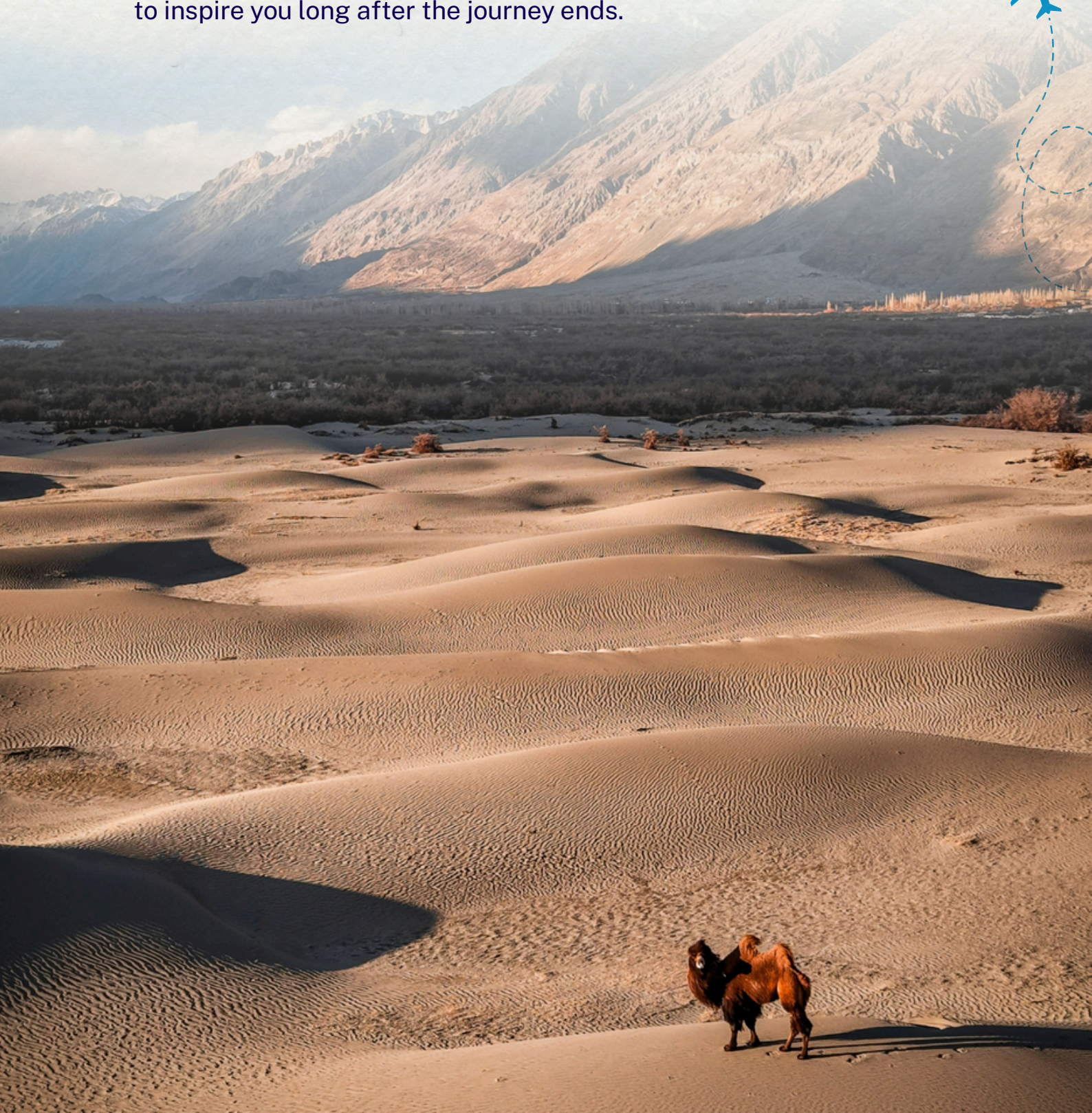
- After breakfast, check out from our Homestay and begin your journey back to Leh. En route, pass through Mahe Bridge and conquer the legendary Umling La, one of the world's highest motorable roads, offering unmatched high-altitude views and an exhilarating driving experience.

Please note that Ladakh, especially during any season, unexpected weather conditions and operates with limited accessibility in certain regions. Many routes – particularly those leading to destinations like Pangong & Nubra, and other mountain areas – are dependent on weather conditions and may be affected by heavy snowfall, road closures, black ice, landslides, or other unforeseen natural events.

In the event of such disruptions, the group may be required to halt their journey at the point of obstruction or adjust travel plans for safety reasons. The duration of any delay is unpredictable and completely beyond human control. These situations may lead to changes in the planned itinerary, including delays, route alterations, missed sightseeing, or the inability to reach certain destinations as scheduled.

While Trekkers United will make every reasonable effort to manage situations smoothly and prioritize guest safety, we shall not be held responsible for any such inconveniences.

● Backpacking Trip – Not a Luxury Tour

This is a true backpacking experience, designed for adventure seekers who love raw, authentic travel. Expect decent comfort, not luxury.

Ladakh is an offbeat and rugged destination, so food and accommodation will be simple & basic – that's the charm of the journey and the essence of real backpacking.

● Flight Information & Booking Policy

Trekkers United packages include land arrangements only. Flight booking is the responsibility of the client. If needed, we can help you with flight options or book tickets on your behalf.

However, Trekkers United is not responsible for flight delays, cancellations, rescheduling, or refund issues.

After paying ₹8,000 as your booking amount to secure your slot, you may:

- Book your Refundable flights directly, or
- Request our assistance. (Full flight payment is required in advance if we book for you.)

● Trip Coordinator Policy

If the group has 8 or more participants, a dedicated trip coordinator will accompany you throughout the journey.

If the group size is below 8, all arrangements will be handled smoothly – however, a physical trip leader will not be present. (Additional charges apply for smaller groups requesting an on-ground leader.)

Please note: Additional charges may be applicable if group size is smaller.

Step 4	Kindly clear the remaining amount 30 days prior to the trip.
Step 5	WhatsApp group for the trip will be created 7-10 days before departure for further communication. For any queries in the meantime, please feel free to WhatsApp us.

FAQS



● **What is the fitness level required for this Trip?**

This is a leisure-oriented backpacking trip and requires basic physical fitness. There are no treks involved, but walking on snow and cold weather conditions may require a reasonable level of stamina.

● **What is the Age group for this Trip?**

This trip is for people from age group 16 - 36yrs only

● **What is the group size ?**

Usually group size is 8 - 20

● **Is the trip safe for solo/female travelers?**

Absolutely! Our trips are suitable for solo travelers, including females. We always have around 25-30% Female/Solo Travelers onboard.

● **Are heaters provided?**

Heating arrangements are available at select hotels and locations,,. Room heaters are not included by default and will be chargeable at some properties.

● **What type of shoes are required?**

Any comfortable shoes with good grip are sufficient. Waterproof shoes are recommended NOT compulsory & trekking shoes are not mandatory.

● **Can all places be covered during winter in Kashmir?**

Ladakh's weather is unpredictable. Heavy snowfall may lead to temporary road closures or restricted access to certain areas due to any factors, In such cases, the itinerary may be adjusted for safety reasons. These conditions are beyond human control.

● **Will I find Jain Food Options?**

Yes Jain food options are available, options will be limited. For Jain people we recommend carrying snacks.

● **What will be the daytime and night temperature?**

- Daytime: Approximately 5°C to 15°C
- Nighttime: Can drop to 0°C to -5°C,

● **Are adventure activities included in the package?**

No. Any adventure activities are not included in the package and are optional..

● **Which SIM card works in Ladakh?**


Postpaid SIM cards work best in Ladakh. Prepaid SIMs from outside Jammu & Kashmir usually do not work. Network connectivity may be limited in remote areas. (Airtel/Jio/BSNL)

REFUND & CANCELLATION

We understand that unexpected changes may occur. However, to maintain clarity for all clients, please review the cancellation guidelines carefully. The booking amount paid at the time of reservation is completely non-refundable under all circumstances.

- Before 45 Days: 50% refund on the booking amount.
45 – 30 Days: No refund on the booking amount.
30 – 20 Days: 25% refund on the total trip cost.
20 – 10 Days: 10% refund on the total trip cost.
After 10 Days: No refund.
- Cancellation charges are calculated on the total trip cost, not on partial or booking amounts. (Example: If your trip costs ₹25,000 and you paid ₹10,000 as an advance, cancellation within 30 days will still apply on ₹25,000)
- If the trip is cancelled from our end, a minimum 7% administrative deduction will be applied. The remaining amount will be issued as a credit note redeemable on future trips. Cash refunds will not be provided. (This clause does not apply for cancellations caused by situations beyond our control)
- Any cancellation or alteration in the trip or specific locations due to natural calamities, sudden weather issues, strikes, government orders, route closures, or any man-made incidents will not be our liability.
 - Any additional expenses arising from such situations must be borne by the client.
 - Our Trip Captain/Coordinator will not accompany the client in these cases, but we will assist in making necessary arrangements.
- Full payment must be completed 30 days before the trip begins. Pending dues may lead to automatic cancellation without refund.
- Amounts paid are non-transferable, and no credit notes will be issued unless specifically mentioned. No refund, credit, or transfer will be provided if the itinerary or route is changed for safety or operational reasons.
- If a client voluntarily quits the trip for personal reasons (fitness, illness, discomfort, or any other reason), no refund or credit will be issued.
 - Any additional expenses due to returning early will be borne solely by the client.
 - Our Trip Captain/Coordinator will not accompany the client, but necessary assistance for arrangements will be provided.
- If a client is asked to return by the Trip/Trek Coordinator due to low fitness, medical concerns, violation of rules, misbehaviour, harassment, being under heavy influence of alcohol/substances, or engaging in any prohibited activity, no refund or credit will be issued.
 - Any extra expenses arising from the client being sent back will be fully borne by the client.
 - Our Trip Captain/Coordinator will not accompany the client but will help arrange the required transport.
- If the entire group must end the trip after commencement due to severe weather, government restrictions, unexpected circumstances, or any uncontrollable event, no refund or voucher will be issued.
- **Extreme Scenarios Clause:**
Situations such as war, pandemic outbreaks, national emergencies, government-imposed restrictions, or any extreme/uncontrollable circumstances before or during the trip may lead to cancellation.
 - In such cases, no refund or credit voucher will be issued.
 - If a client fails to pay the remaining balance by the due date, the booking may be automatically cancelled without any refund of the booking amount.





TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Clients are solely responsible for their personal belongings throughout the trip. Trekkers United is not liable for any loss, Theft or damage of baggage or valuables.
- Company vehicles provide transportation only to and from the locations mentioned in the itinerary. Any additional travel arranged by us will be chargeable.
- Sightseeing is subject to weather, traffic, delays, breakdowns, client punctuality, seasonal rush, and operational limitations. Trekkers United is not responsible if any sightseeing cannot be completed for such reasons.
- In case of trip extension due to weather or unforeseen situations, clients must pay ₹2,500 per day (cash) directly to the Trip/Trek Coordinator. Any additional expenses caused due to such situations will be borne by the client.
- The itinerary, accommodations, timings, or transport arrangements may be modified due to safety concerns or operational requirements. Trekkers United's decision will be final.
- Mode of transport (train/bus/vehicle) may change depending on availability, including boarding/dropping points, without prior notice.
